

## Application Tips

- 1) Match your seminar choice to a core subject you teach. (Science teachers choose science/math, math teachers choose science/math, English teachers choose English/humanities etc.)
- 2) Your idea for your unit should clearly fit the seminar description.
- 3) Be flexible. Apply and be willing to choose an alternate seminar.
- 4) If you have questions, ASK.
- 5) Be creative. Find SOLs that correspond to the seminar, then think outside the box.
